- He sent and signified *it* by His angel to His servant John
- Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near.


The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might,

- Born at Bethsaida to Zebedee and Salome
- Galilean fisherman
- In partners with Peter and Andrew
- Early disciple of John the Baptist
- Well connected
- High Priest, Nicodemus, et al (John 18:15)?
- One of the inner circle
- Mt. Transfiguration (Matt. 17) Peter, James and John
- Raising of Jairus' daughter (Matt:18)
- Olivet Discourse (Matt. 24)
- Gethsemane (Matt. 26.37)
- Assigned care of Mary (John 19:26)
- Ultimately retires to Ephesus aft his exile

Ultimately retires to Ephesus after his exile (81-96 AD)





THE PATMOS EXILE


- Exiled by Domitian (81-96 AD) the brother of Titus who destroyed Jerusalem in 70 AD.
- History
- Hippolytus:
- John was first plunged into a boiling oil, and then sent to this island exile
- Victorinus:
- John was forced to work in the mines that were located on Patmos
- Irenaeus, Clement, and Eusebius:
- After Domitian dies, John returned to Ephesus, went to the churches, and appointed leaders, and set things in order



- I was in the Spirit on the Lord's Day, and I heard behind me a loud voice, as of a trumpet,
- What day is the Lord's Day?
- Seventh Day ordained in Eden (Genesis 2)
- Observed before the giving of the Law
- Did not gather manna on Shabbat (Exodus 16)
- Law given at Mt. Sinai (Exodus 20)
- Antichrist will seek "to change the times and laws" (Daniel 7:25)
- "Do not move the ancient landmarks..." Proverbs 22:28
- Millennial Temple only be open on Shabbat and the new moon (Ezekiel 46:1)
- The Lord's Appointed Times (Leviticus 23)
- Paul "So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths, ¹⁷ which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ." Colossians 2:16-17



- He had in His right hand seven stars
